1. In November of 2008, Michigan voters approved a new state law allowing the medical use of marijuana. The new law allows seriously ill people in Michigan to legally use marijuana for medical reasons with doctors' approval and permits these qualified patients and their caregivers to grow limited amounts of marijuana for their own medical use. The use of marijuana in public or while driving remains illegal.
