## METHODOLOGY

- Data presented are the summary of surveying 801 registered voters in South Carolina. Each respondent was part of a representative sample based on current voter registration statistics. Data was stratified to represent accurate proportions in vital characteristics including race, age, gender, geography and political persuasion.
- Field dates were February 16-19, 2021.
- Respondents were contacted by telephone using a combination of valid residential and cellular telephone listings.
- The margin of error for a survey of this type is $\pm 3.9 \%$ in 19 out of 20 cases.

- Support for medical marijuana remains strong in South Carolina-by an almost 5:1 ratio!
- While the ratio of support (not surprisingly) is greatest in the Lowcountry, no statistically-significant regional differences exist.
